
First patient randomised!

How to get started...

Prior to opening your Site to patient recruitment, the following processes/documentation need to be completed:

- local R&D approval (copy sent to the ICNARC CTU);
- Clinical Trial Site Agreement signed;
- Delegation of Trial Duties Log / Site Research Staff Contact Form completed (copies sent to the ICNARC CTU);
- Vigileo Monitor and PreSep catheters in place, and Vigileo Monitor checked by local clinical engineering department;
- training on the use of the Vigileo Monitor provided by Edwards Lifesciences, (and training log completed);
- attendance at a Site Initiation Meeting and receipt of an Investigator Site File (one file per Site);
- access to the ProMISe secure, dedicated, web-based data entry system (see protocol) approved;
- receipt of Site activation email, indicating that your Site is open to patient recruitment!
